Materials and Tools

• Yarn: 1 or more color of yarn calling for 2,5 mm needles. I use <u>soft cotton</u> №8, Merino wool and baby wool. I don't recommend you use thick or hard yarns. It's possible to use acrylic yarn.

Change of colors are only advices, you can choose your own color patterns.

- Crochet hook: 2,5 mm
- Stuffing material: I use polyester wool and a chopstick to stuff the doll.
- Tapestry needle, scissors.
- Plastic safety eyes 4.00 mm (Do not forget to place them before finishing the head).
- Dark thin yarn or thread to embroider the eyelashes.

Abbreviations

mr = Magic ring

ch = Chain

st = Stitch

slst = Slip 1 stitch

sc = Single crochet

() = Parentheses are used for repeated patterns of stitches, example: (sc 2, inc) x3 means repeat 3 times (2 simple crochet and one increase).

inc = 2 sc in the same stitch

dec = sc 2 together but working in the front loops only

inc dc=2 dc in the same stitch





Animals are crocheted in spiral, don't join at the end of each round.

Use the 2,5 mm hook.






How to crochet right leg:

In opposite side, insert the hook in 18 stitch of body (fig 16) and crocheted first stitch of left leg (fig 17). Pick up the yarn, pull it through (fig 18) and make 1 starting chain. Insert the hook again in the same stitch and make your first single crochet of right leg (fig 19)

How to finish legs:

Insert the needle from outside to insede under the front loop of the next stitch. Repeat fot each stitch, cut the yarn and hide the tail in leg (fig 22 and 23).





ARMS

Use the 2,5 mm hook. Arm is crocheted in spiral.


Insert the hook in first stitch of arm and crocheted stitch of body (fig 25, 26). Pick up the yarn, pull it through and make 1 starting chain (fig 27). Insert the hook again in the same stitch and make your first stitch of arm. Follow the pattern.

Before to crochet round 7, stuff the arm.













Finish the arms similarly like legs.




Teddy Bear

Use the pattern to make a body of teddy bear.

EARS				
Use the 2,5 mm hook.

Cut the yarn keeping same length.







For the left ear, insert your needle across a stitch of the head. You will sew it from front to back. Then insert the needle under <u>front loop</u> of the ear (fig 2) and across the next stitch on the body. Sew the right arm similarly, but from the back to the front.

FACE Use the 2,5 mm hook. Face is crocheted in spiral. **ROUND PATTERN** #st 1-6 sc in magic ring 6 2-12 (1 inc) x6 3-(1 sc, 1 inc) x6 18 4-18 sc around 18

Finish with 1 back slip stitch, stuff a little bit, cut the yarn and keep some length.





Sew the face to the head using the back loops. Insert the needle across the stitch on head, then insert needle under the back loop and across the next stitch of head (fig 4, 5). Embroider the nose, mouth and eyebrows with thin yarn.



Monkey

Use the pattern to make a body of monkey.

EARS

Use the 2,5 mm hook. Thea are crocheted in spiral.

2-	(1 inc) x6	12
3-	(1 sc, 1 inc) x6	18
4-	18 sc around (fig 1)	18

Cut the yarn keeping same length.







Sew the ear to head between rounds 7 and 10. For the left ear, insert the needle across a stitch of head (fig 2). You will sew it from up to down. Then insert the needle across the stitch of ear and next stitch of the head (fig 3). Repeat two times. Sew the right ear similarly, but from down to up.

FACE

Use the 2,5 mm hook. The face is crocheted in spiral.

Finish with 1 back slip stitch, stuff, cut the yarn and keep some length.







Sew the face to the head using back loops of face. First insert needle across a stitch of head, then under back loop of face and next stitch of head (fig 5, 6).







Hair: cut 5-7 pieces of thread 6 cm long and fold it in half. Take a hook smaller. Insert it between magic ring and stitches of first round. Pick up the loop (fig 7), pull it through (fig 8), then pull it up through loop (fig 9).

Embroider the nose, mouth and brows.

BAW-KNOT

In magic ring, 3 start chains, 5 dc, 3 ch, make two pieces, between pieces 1 slst (fig 10). Turn thread around few times.







Sew the baw-knot to body. Insert the needle under two stitches of body (fig 11), then under threats of baw-knot. Repeat few times.



Elephant

Use the pattern, to make a body of elephant.

Use the 2.5 mm hook. The trunk is crocheted in spiral using only back loops.

Finish with 1 back slip stitch, stuff, cut the yarn and leave a long tail.













Place and fix the trunk with tail to down (fig 2). Take a needle, sew trunk around to head using only bar of last round (fig 3). Insert needle across the stitch of the head, then under the bar and next stitch of head. Finish your sewing in the beginning (fig 4). Then insert needle through front loops to round 9 (fig 5). Pull up the thread, return back to beginning and fix the thread doing in that way curve form of trunk (fig 6).

EARS

Use the 2,5 mm hook. From third round we are crocheted tracery stitches. Leave a long tail of yarn to sew the ear to head, before to make 11 chains.

How to make tracery stitch:

Bring the yarn around the loop from left to right putting it on loop. Now the yarn lays on the loop, insert the hook in next stitch and make first tracery stitch (fig 8, 9). Make next stitches similarly.















Use the yarn tail to sew the ear. For left ear, follow from down to up. Insert needle across a stitch of head, then insert it under a loop of ear and next stitch on head (fig 12, 13). Sew the right ear similarly, but from up to down.


Use the pattern to make a body of bunny.

Use the 2,5 mm hook. Ears are crocheted in spiral.

Cut the yarn keeping some length.








For the left ear, insert your needle across a stitch of the head (fig 2). You will sew it from front to back. Then insert the needle under <u>front loop</u> of the ear (fig 3) and across the next stitch on the body. Sew the right arm similarly, but from the back to the front.

Fold last 6 round in half, use the needle, sew two sides together. Crochet 51 chains, then make 50 sc.



Tiger

Use the pattern to make a body of tiger.

FACE Use the 2,5 mm hook. **ROUND PATTERN** #st 1-6 sc in magic ring 6 2-(1 inc) x6 12 3-(1 sc, 1 inc) x6 18 4-18 sc around 18

Finish with 1 back slip stitch, stuff a little bit, cut the yarn and keep some length.





Sew the face to the head using the back loops. Insert the needle across the stitch on head, then under the back loop of face and across the next stitch of head (fig 1, 2).

EARS

Use the 2,5 mm hook.

For the left ear, insert your needle across a stitch of the head. You will sew it from front to back. Then insert the needle under_loop of the ear and across the next stitch on the body. Sew the right arm similarly, but from the back to the front.







Stripes: embroider stripes on the body, head, legs and arms using needle with black color yarn across two, three rounds between (fig 6, 7).

Fold the ear in half, join the two sides together using the needle (fig 2 and 3). Don't sew all ear.







Sew the left ear to head, insert needle under a stitch of head, then insert the needle under the front loop of ear and next stitch of head (fig 4, 5). You will sew left ear around from up to down. Sew the right ear similarly, but from down to up.

HORNS (big part)

Use the 2,5 mm hook



Fox

Use the pattern to make a body.

<u>Rounds 32, 34</u> of body crochet using only back loops.

Before to attach yarn and crochet arms, make a skirt.







Lay your body with back side at the facing you. Attach the yarn in first loop of round 34 and make 1 starting chain (fig 1, 2). Then insert hook in next loop and pull up thread through two loops (fig 3). Repeat it 32 times (fig 4). Finish with 1 slipstitch in first loop (fig 5).





Round 1: use only back loops, make 3 starting chains, 1 double crochet in the same loop, in next loops 1 inc dc, finish with 1 slst (64 stitches) (fig 6).

Rounds 3 and 4: start with 3 ch, make 1 dc in each stitch, finish with 1 slst (fig 7, 8).







Similarly crochet second part of skirt (fig 9, 10, 11). I made until round 4.







COLLAR

Use the 2,5 mm hook. Crochet 24 chains, use the pattern to make petals, join them with 1 slip stitch.



Sew collar to body, first fix it with needles (fig 13). Insert needle across stitch of body, then under loop of collar and next stitch of body (fig 14, 15).







FACE

Use the 2,5 mm hook.

Donkey

Make the body using the pattern.






Hair:_cut 5-7 pieces of thread 6 cm long and fold it in half. Take a hook smaller size. Insert it between magic ring and stitch of first round. Pick up the yarn (fig 1), pull it through, then insert the hook again in loop and pull the threads through loop (fig 2).

EARS

Use two yarn colors.

Make 10 chains: in second chain from hook, 2 sc, 2 hdc, 1 dc, 2 hdc, 1 sc, 3 sc in last chain, opposite side: 1 sc, 2 hdc, 1 dc, 2 hdc, 2sc, 1 slst (fig 3, 4 and 5).

Make 4, two of one color and two of another color.









Don't cut a blue yarn, we continue to make a binding.


Fold two ears with back side inside. Insert the hook under the stitch of white ear and pull the loop of second ear through (fig 6, 7). Make 1 ch (fig 8), insert the hook again under stitches, pick up the yarn and pull it through two stitches and loop (fig 9, 10). Before to make slip stitch, <u>crochet 1 chain</u>.













For left ear, insert needle across stitch of head, then insert needle under loop of ear and next stitch of head. Sew it from up to down (fig 12, 13). Sew the right ear similarly, but from down to up.





FACE

Panda

Make the body using the pattern.

Rounds 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 37, legs and arms with black yarn (fig 4, 5 and 6).

BLACK AROUNDS

Use the 2,5 mm hook.

Finish with 1 back slip stitch, cut the yarn and keep some length.







First attack the eye through black around and then to head.







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Sew the black around using the font loop. First insert needle across stitch of head, then under front loop of around and next stitch of head.

EARS Use the 2,5 mm hook. The ears are crocheted in spiral. **ROUND PATTERN** #st 1-6 sc in magic ring 6 2-(1 inc) x6 12 3-(5 sc, 1 inc) x2 14 4-5-14 sc around 14

Cut the yarn and leave a tail to sew.

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Use the 2.5 mm hook. Face is crocheted in spiral

Rounds 32, 34 are crocheted using only back loops. Before to crochet arms, make skirt. How it do see the skirt descriptions of fox.



NOSE

Use the 2,5 mm hook. Nose is crocheted in spiral.

5-	change yarn, 20 sc around using only front loops (fig 3)	20

Cut the yarn and keep some length.

Sew the nose to head using back loops of nose (fig 4).

Use the 2,5 mm hook. Ears are crocheted with tracery stitches.


